1. Will E. 65th re-open between Euclid and Carnegie? Will all curbs/drives be fixed along Carnegie, or is this the property owner's responsibility?

Response: No, this road has been vacated and is now Private. This project will repair damaged curbs and drive aprons within project limits along Carnegie Avenue.

2. Additional traffic calming needed to be explored. The aspect of installing elements of a boulevard (Reminiscent of Clifton Boulevard and roads past Edgewater). Residents want more aesthetics, barriers/buffers and well curated landscaped medians and skirts would solve multiple problems.

Response: This project will replace portions of sidewalk with treelawn. Also added median and mid-block pedestrian crossings to improve aesthetics and safety. We will be meeting with Urban Forestry in June to discuss tree placement options.

3. Glad to see the medians and narrowing under the NSRR bridge. We need treelawns and space for trees to be planted. With regards to crashes at 77th St. and Carnegie - Median, RRFB and new Traffic light would really make it safer.

Response: This project will replace portions of sidewalk with treelawn to improve aesthetics. We will be meeting with Urban Forestry in June to discuss tree placement options.
